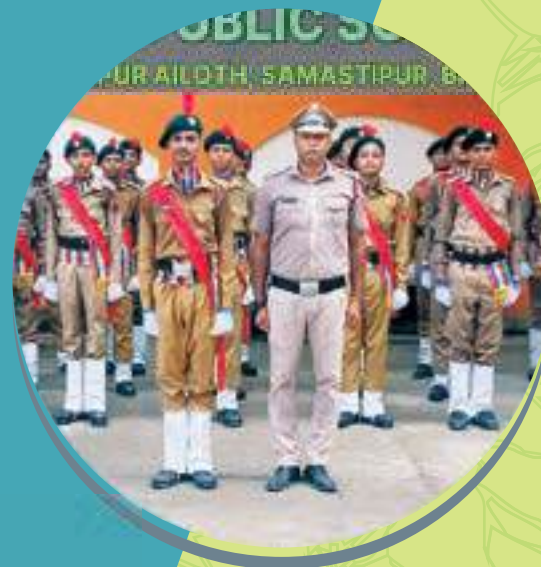

VISION & VISIONARIES

DAV institutions are the gift of Arya Samaj, a progressive movement founded by Swami Dayanand Saraswati in 1875. Swami Dayanand Saraswati, the great path maker of modern India, led a crusade against the superstitions and pernicious practices that prevailed in contemporary India.

With a view to bring about a balanced and harmonious development of the future citizens of this country and to infuse in them the ideals of Vedic Culture and high sense of patriotism, Arya Samaj founded a school at Lahore in 1886 by the name of Dayanand Anglo Vedic School. This established the DAV College Trust & Management Society, which later set up a network of such educational institutions all over India and abroad.

DAV Movement got momentum due to the dedicated and committed services of young and brilliant graduate Mahatma Hansraj, the first Principal of the first DAV school at Lahore. He offered selfless service without accepting any remuneration from the institution.

The DAV movements have rendered a unique service in not only dispelling ignorance and illiteracy but also by producing Patriots, Freedom Fighters, Social Reformers, Intellectuals, Doctors, Engineers and Sports Persons of unparalleled merit, integrity and caliber. Presently, it is the largest non-government Educational Organization in the country managing over 919 Educational Institutions.

Our Guiding Souls



**Swami Dayanand Saraswati:
(1824- 1883)**

The founder of the Arya Samaj and the great path-maker of modern India. DAV came into existence to realize the prophetic vision of this great philosopher.



Swami Shraddhanand: (1856- 1926)

A Visionary, Educationist and a great patriot who holds a unique position in the annals of Arya Samaj. A great supporter of Vedic Education who established the first Gurukul of its kind at Kangri near Haridwar.



Mahatma Hansraj: (1864-1938)

Frail of body but possessing heroic spirit, voluntarily opted for a life of self denial and renunciation. He fulfilled his pledge of 25 years of honorary service as the first Principal of the first DAV College at Lahore.



Lala Lajpat Rai: (1865-1928)

He founded and nurtured the great DAV Movement. He helped to establish the nationalistic Dayanand Anglo-Vedic School & became a follower of Dayanand Saraswati, the founder of the Hindu society Arya Samaj "Society of reformist Noble People".



Mahatma Anand Swami: (1882-1977)

He was a staunch follower of Arya Samaj. He played a pivotal role in Hyderabad Arya Satyagrah. In 1948 he adopted sanyas from Swami Atmanand & continued propagating the principles and values of Arya Samaj in India and abroad.



**Mahatma Narayan Das Grover:
(1923-2008)**

He nurtured the seeds of DAV with his sweat and blood and brought up DAV as the largest institutional chain in Bihar & Jharkhand.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The main purpose of enrolling our students in it is to provide a platform for youth engagement, adult resource management, social awareness & effective communication.

TRANSPORT FACILITIES

- ☛ Transport facility is available for the students within the town area at a nominal cost.

BLOSSOMING OF LATENT TALENTS



- ☛ We expose our students to hobbies like playing, reading, sketching, singing, dancing, and gardening and ensure that discipline becomes a second nature of the child.
- ☛ Individual and consistent monitoring of every student enables the teacher to recognize the field in which a particular child can excel.
- ☛ Children with similar interests and inclinations are grouped together and then the teachers help them to nurse and cultivate their talents.
- ☛ Children are also trained in yoga, martial arts, dance and music by experts.



ORIENTATION PROGRAM FOR TEACHERS:

Under the guidance of DAV centre for academic excellence, New Delhi. (Empaneled by CBSE, Delhi), orientation programs and workshops are conducted for the Principals and teachers to enhance their skills.

CAREER COUNSELING AND PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT CLASSES:

Career counseling and Adolescent Education program are arranged for our secondary and Senior Secondary students. Personality development classes are arranged for all the students round the year.



ADMISSION

- For Admission in Nursery and LKG, a random selection process/lottery system is adopted as per C.B.S.E. Norms.
- Admission in classes UKG to VIII is made strictly on the basis of merit through the entrance test and interview.
- Fee has to be deposited within seven days of selection, failing which the seat will be allotted to the next wait listed candidate.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

The following documents are to be submitted along with the admission form:

- Date of Birth Certificate from the competent authorities.
- Transfer Certificate for the students of classes II onwards.
- Medical Certificate from MBBS doctor.
- Four passport size and two stamp size photographs.
- Affidavit from 1st class magistrate

REGISTRATION AND ENTRANCE TEST

- The prospectus and registration form can be obtained from the school counter on cash payment.
- The filled in registration form along with the required documents must be submitted to the school office on or before the stipulated date.
- The registered candidates may be called for the written test and the interview.
- Mere registration does not guarantee confirmation of admission.





SESSION: The school session is from April to March.

WITHDRAWALS

- Withdrawals from any class must be preceded by one month notice in writing or one month fee in lieu thereof.
- All dues will have to be cleared before the Transfer Certificate is issued.
- Transfer Certificate will be issued after one week of receiving the application.

School authorities may ask the parents without prior notice to withdraw the child from the school on any of the following grounds:

1. ACADEMICS

Constant weakness in studies or those who fail in the same class for two consecutive sessions.

2. DISCIPLINARY

Those students whose conduct in the opinion of the School Management is harmful to the interests of the institution.

3. FEE ARREAR

Due to non-payment of fees for three consecutive months.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- The school reserves the right to revise the Tuition fee and other fee at the end of the session which will be noticed one month before the start of the new session. The school also reserves the right to revise the Transport fees (due to hike in fuel prices) during the session.
- The school is a non-profit making and unaided institution; hence, it can propose interest free loan and extra refundable security money, which will be binding on all the students concerned.
- Name of the student will be struck off in case of indiscipline act on the part of student or the concerned parents/guardians.
- The student, who damages the school property, will have to pay for the loss. If a particular student is not found then all the students of the concerned class or group will have to pay for the loss.
- Registration fee is non-refundable.
